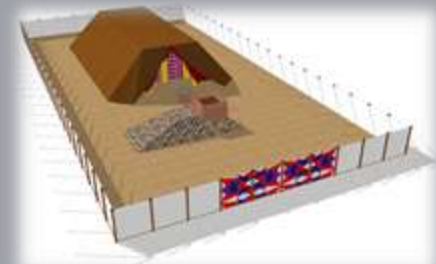

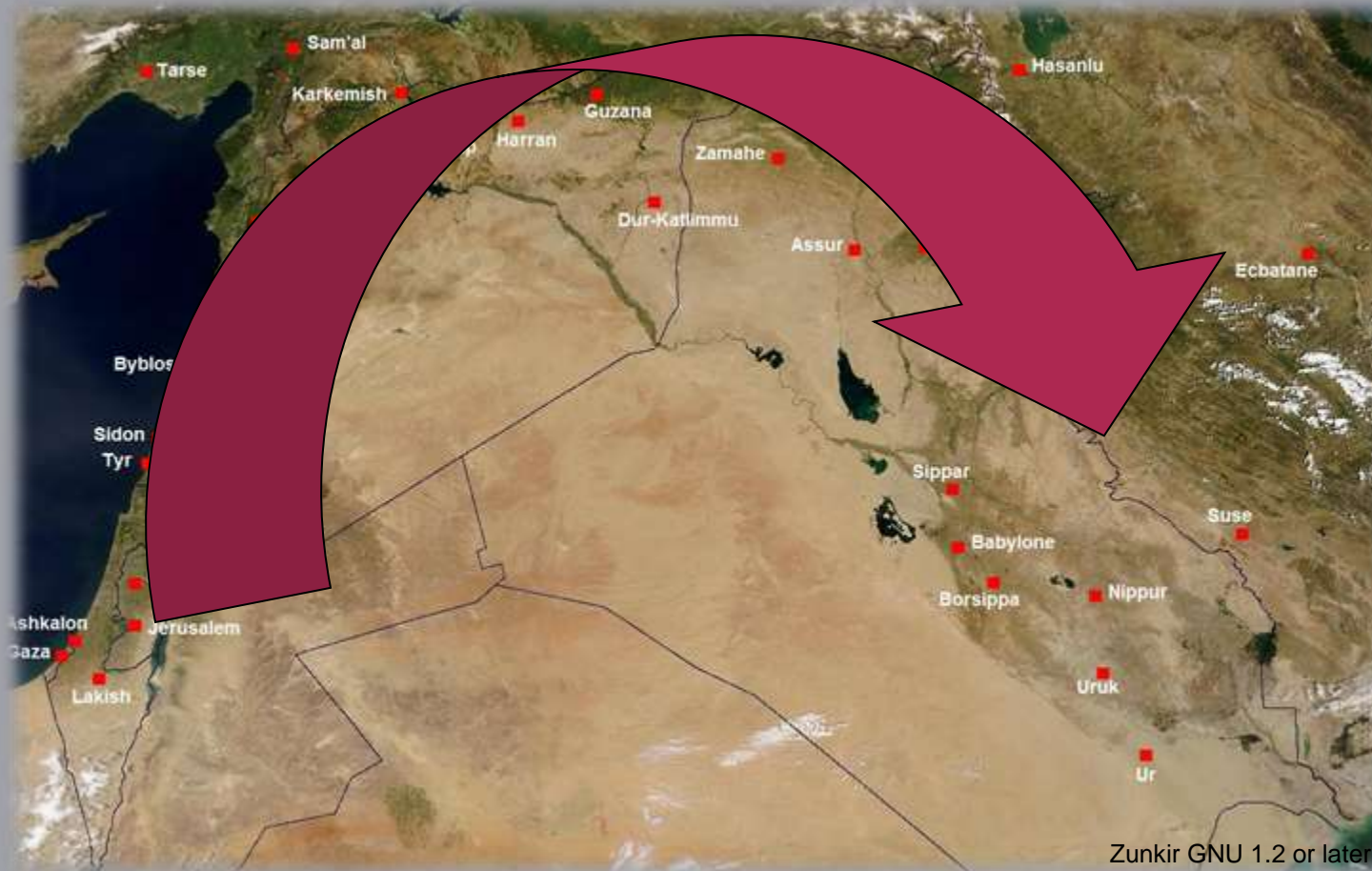

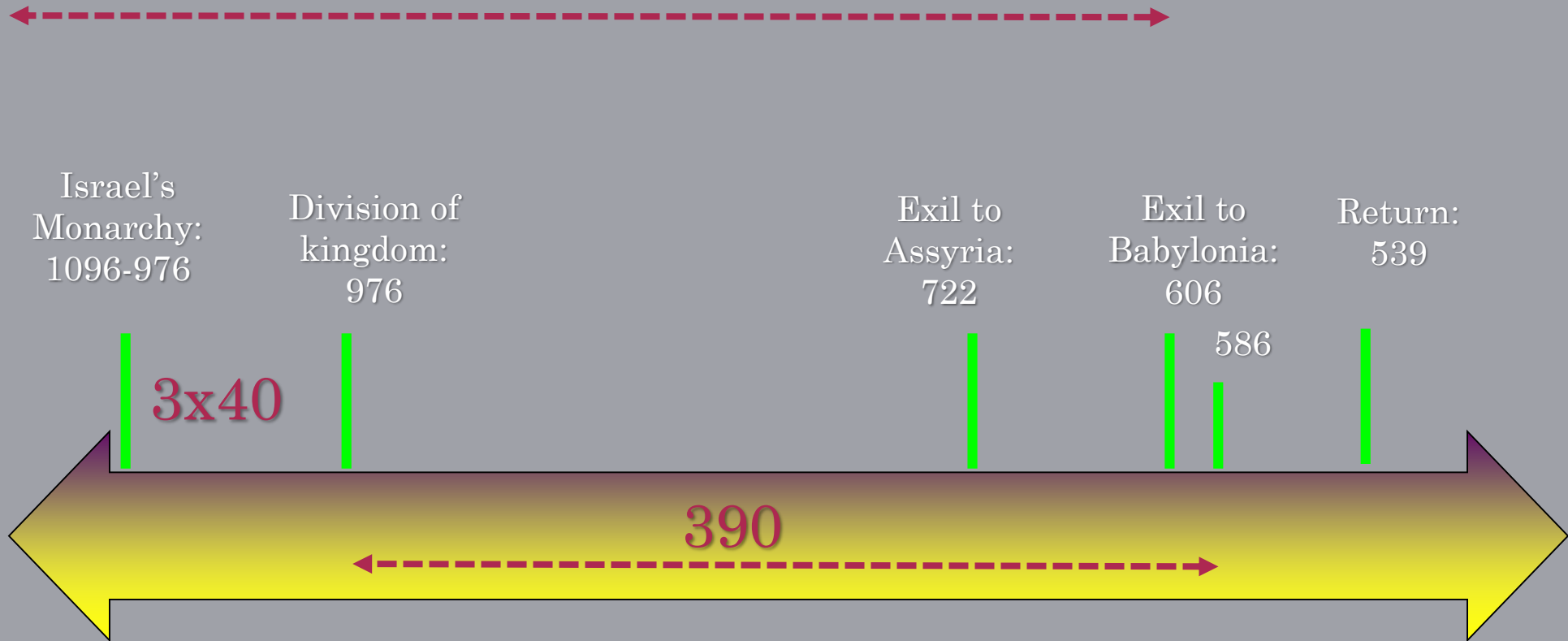

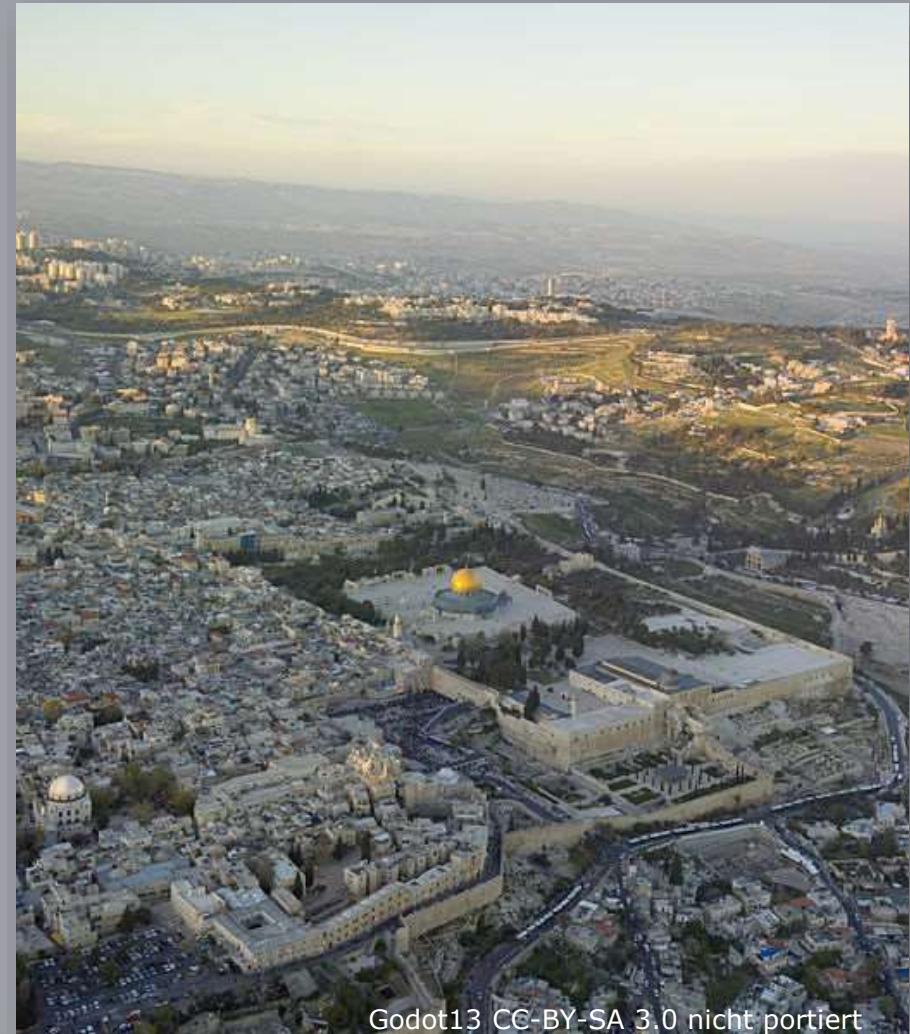

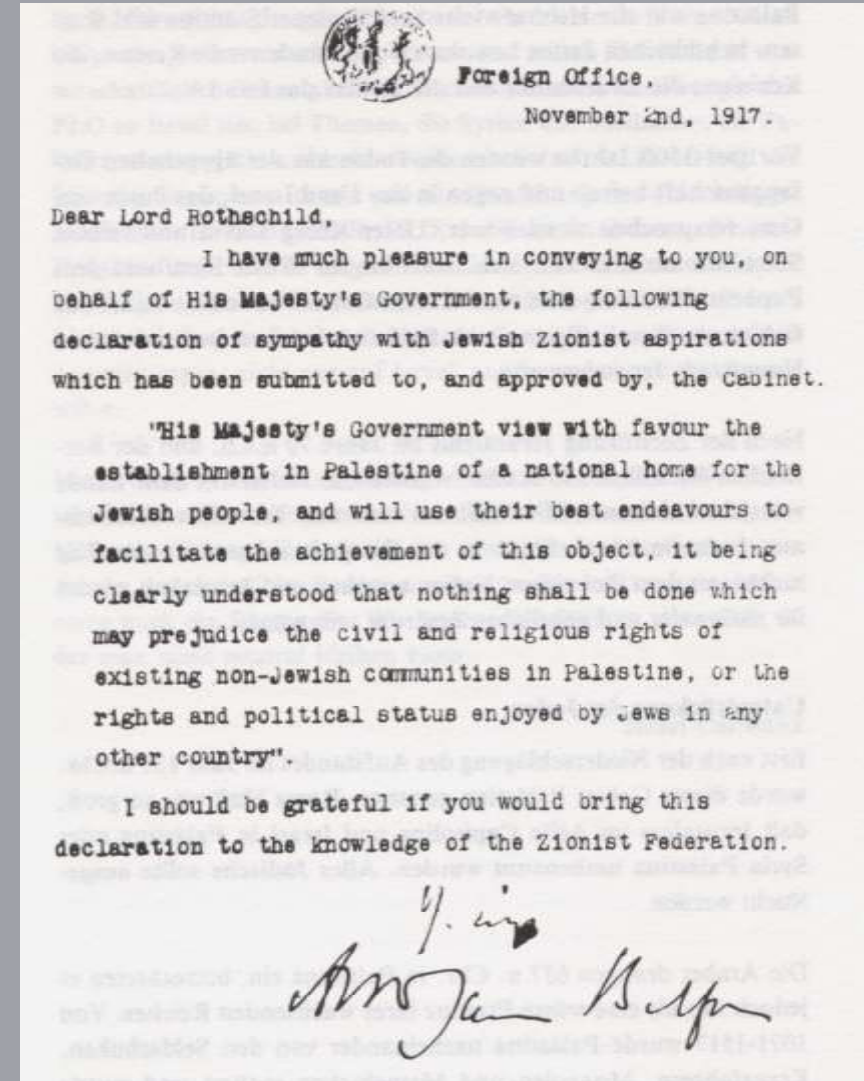

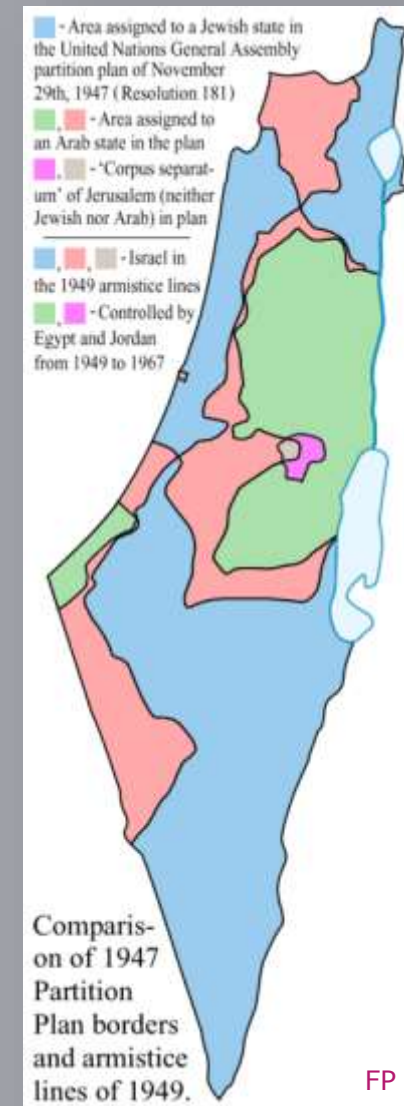

➤ **After one year:**
Israel survives and emerges victorious with a gain of territory.

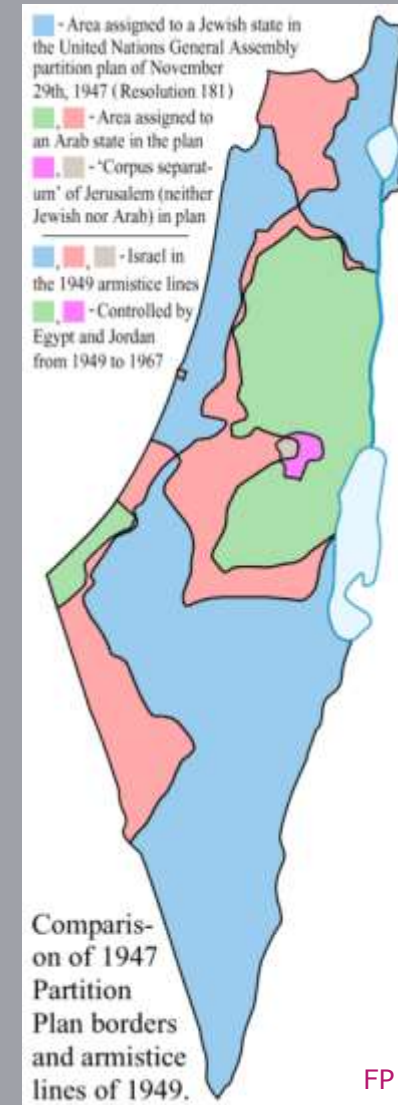

July 49: Ceasefire by the UN

- Jordan annexed the West Bank in 1950, with East Jerusalem and the Temple Mount.
